Sub: Grievances of Promotee Officers – regarding.

We wish to bring to your kind attention the following long pending issues for early redressal:

- Early conduct of Formal Meeting with IRPOF on single point agenda with regard to Miscellaneous cadre. Solicit your intervention.
- Induction to Group 'A' of Promotee Officers is done on yearly basis but Indian Railways is lagging behind the DOP&T calendar by 1 ½ years to two years with regard to the empanelment for promotion. In terms of the guidelines of the DOP&T, the panel should be available on the date of the vacancy. It is suggested that the panel cannot be formed in time, and then seniority should be given from the vacancy year.
- It is requested that as laid down in the guidelines, General Managers of zonal railways may hold two formal meetings in a year, so that local issues can be discussed and resolved. In this regard a revised instruction to all Zonal Railways may be issued for holding formal meetings.
- Reduction of residency period for Selection Grade from 12 years to 10 years.
